

The following information supplements the 1999 & 2000 Annual Water Quality Report originally published in 1999 & 2000:

The Village of Waterloo's Water Treatment Plants' business address is 41 W. Main St. , Waterloo, N.Y. The owner of the system is the Village of Waterloo, Mayor - Lee Patchen, NYS Certified Plant Operator - Jim Bromka. (539-9131, 585-9811) The Federal I.D. No. is 4901199. Regular board meetings are held the second Monday of each month. Nearly 8,000 people in and around the village are served by the system. The system did not experience any restriction of water due to source contaminants from Seneca Lake, the supply for the system. A source water assessment is available upon request at the Seneca County Health Dept. Raw water is disinfected with chlorine & filtered with diatomaceous filters before being released to the distribution system. NO Positive Coliform or E. coli samples were found in any of the distribution system in 1998 or 1999. Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) means the highest level of contaminant that is allowed in drinking water. Maximum contaminant Level Goal (MCLG) means the level of a contaminant in drinking water below which there is no known or expected health risk. Not Detected (ND) means the testing methods and equipment used could not detect any contaminants. The Village of Waterloo's water system is fairly "water-tight". The system can account for 91% of all water metered from the master meter at the water treatment plant on Seneca Lake. The recommendation is that customers use water conservation devices in their homes. A pamphlet on such is available at the Seneca Co. Health Dept. (539-1945) Water costs \$4.22/1,000 gals. of water to village residents. Rates vary to outside the village customers. Major modifications are currently underway including adding another filter and changing from chlorine to chloramines for disinfection in the distribution system. More information regarding chloramination will follow. This report is published in the Reville on 11/9/00 & later on the Village of Waterloo's website.
